Main topics

This two-day masterclass will be delivered using a mixture of brief lectures (supported by explanatory slides), practical demonstration, and hands-on practice. We will start with a series of shorter explanations and exercises and then look to apply what we have learned on an exclusive bust, sculpted by Jamie, included as part of the cost of the course.

The main topics we will cover are:

- Understanding the components of colour
- How to express ourselves by "playing" with colour
- Creating compelling compositions with focus
- Using brushstrokes for enhanced expression

Student level: Advanced

For this class you should be prepared with an advanced skill level. You should know about zenital light, basic color theory, contrast range and how to create a blending.
