Course Content Over the Weekend

As mentioned earlier, this course builds on Roman's beginner course and the knowledge imparted there. Join Roman on another journey into the world of colors and painting methods. This time, we dive even deeper into Roman's brain:

Main topics:

- Learn to paint atmosphere in a Miniature Project
- Learn to keep everything in your project balanced in harmony
- · Learn quick and effective rules to create better bases
- combine this knowledge to plan and tell stories with your vision
- Learn to paint skintones
- · Learn to paint the colors 'black' and 'white'
- Advanced Color Theory
- Advanced Blending Techniques
- Advanced Happy Painting Methods
- ... and more!

Miniatures for this class vary and will be picked by Roman. The course model will feature figures from Hasslefree Miniatures in **32mm scale**. However, they won't always be the same figures. More details will be given during the course. The choice of figures is based on their suitability for my **teaching objectives**. Unfortunately, personal preferences cannot be accommodated.

What Happens in the Course?

Each participant will be guided in their personal painting development throughout the weekend. The above-mentioned focal points form the backbone of this carefully structured course concept and take the participant on a journey into the deeper realms of Roman's interconnected "painting synapses."

By combining theoretical knowledge with practical application, a package is created that continues to support participants after the course, sharpening their senses for **harmony**, **composition**, **and natural balance** between base and figure. Roman focuses entirely on **coaching the participants** and does not paint his own model.

This course is aimed at **advanced figure painters** who want to take a **big step forward** in their painting skills. Many techniques will be assumed as prior knowledge and will not be re-explained in detail.

Student level: Advanced

For this class you should be prepared with an advanced skill level. You should know about zenital light, basic color theory, contrast range and how to create a blending.

Note: This material list may seem odd to those who haven't attended the beginner course or any other workshop yet. You are experienced painters and course attendees, so please bring what you need.

I kindly ask you to bring a small variety of different basing material as due travelling on international workshops Roman can not transport plenty.

Provided materials per participant:

- Workshop figure
- Limited number of Materials for base design
- Wire for pinning
- Limited number of Materials for finishing the base
- 36 paged, detailed, printed, handout

Materials that participants must bring themselves:

- Your wet palette
- Your paints
- Your brushes
- Your tools for figure preparation
- Two corks for securing the figure
- Pattafix
- Primer spray (1x white / 1x black, ideally from GW)
- Water containers (preferably 2)
- Super glue
- Your painting lamp
- Pens for writing and taking notes
- Notebook to write something in
- Seat cushion if needed
- Multi-socket power strip
- Transport container for taking the figures home
